



Do not use on meat animals. The product may be sprayed or wiped on to the animal's coat and will protect your animal from biting flies. The product will also impart a bright sheen to the animal's coat. Apply regularly during fly season.

AS A SPRAY

Select a hand sprayer which will apply the product in a fine mist or fog. Use one to two ounces per animal per day. Also treat adjacent stable areas for more effective fly control. Do not wet the animal's skin. After

to treat legs, belly, the neck and the facial areas as well as the back line. Do not wet skin. After this application, brush the coat to bring out a bright sheen. Repeat as needed to kill and repel biting flies. During fly-time best protection will be given by treating animals 3 to 4 times each week.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not contaminate feed or feeding utensils. Cover or remove feed before spraying.

Apply to the animal's coat and brush the coat to bring out a bright sheen. Repeat as needed to kill and repel biting flies. During fly-time best protection will be given by treating animals 3 to 4 times each week.

NOTICE: Sulfonamide drugs from the bacterial infections of the respiratory tract and other infections. Since some animals of various breeds have different susceptibilities to these chemicals and certain animals may be particularly sensitive, it is recommended that a small amount of the product be tested on a few animals before spraying the entire herd.
