Effects begin to show after a few weeks may be required for complete control. For lawns with many weeds, re-spray with SUPER WEED-NO-MORE LAWN CARE with water in your hose-end or pump sprayer.

OTHER USE PRECAUTIONS: Do not apply to lawns, flowers, ornamental plants. Do not apply within 3 feet of plants such as bentgrass, carpetgrass, etc.

CONTROLS: Bedstraw, Black Clover, Dandelion, Dock, Ground Squirrel, Lespedeza, Mallow, Morning Glory, Poison Ivy, Poison Oak, Speedwell, Spurge, Wild Carrot, etc.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

"Spot-Treat" weeds in the yard. Shake well. For best results, apply when weeds are young and actively growing. Do not water lawn within 24 hours after spraying. No bending, no stooping; just invert can, aim at nozzle and press valve. Only a short burst is needed. Overspraying only wastes the chemical.

Results begin to show after a few days and weeds gradually die. Up to 4 applications may be required for complete kill. Repeat in 3-4 weeks if necessary. For lawns with many weeds, requiring an overall treatment, use ACME WEED-NO-MORE LAWN WEED KILLER. You'll have to mix it with water in your hose-end or pressure-sprayer as it is concentrated.

PRECAUTIONS: Do not allow spray to drift onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants. Do not apply within tripline of desirable plants. Sensitive grasses such as bentgrass, carpetgrass or St. Augustine may be injured if con-
