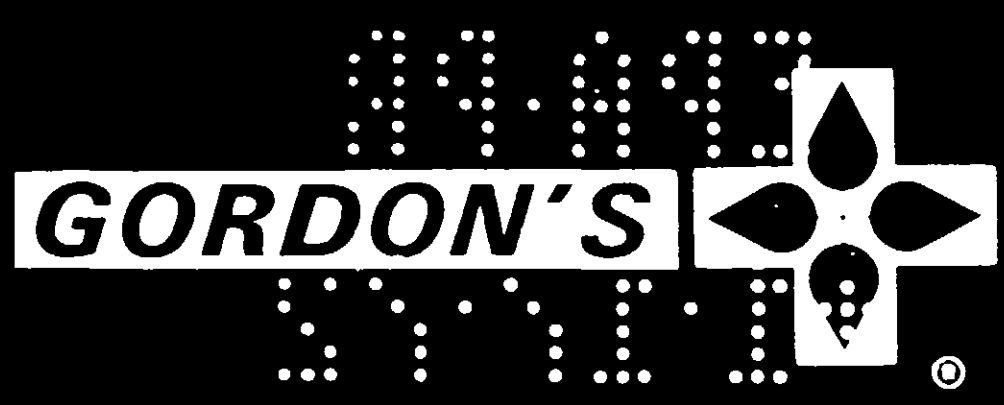

nutgrass killer

grass may occur.
For best results, mow lawn just before treating. Cut grass to a height of about 1½ to 2½ inches.
Do not apply to newly seeded lawns.

When to Apply:
Nutgrass Killer can be applied anytime when temperatures are above 75° F. Apply early because young plants are easier to kill. If lawn has been infested in past years, a flush of new growth may follow the first application. Repeat treatments as needed.

How to Apply:
Where only a few Nutgrass plants are found, place 2 or 3 drops of undiluted Nutgrass Killer directly in the crown of the
