Settyrad 13 wills @fill Tult Apply Sentgrass Permits at the late of 8 to 4 pints per acre in sufficient water for uniform coverage. If herdy weeds persist, make a second application after three weeks. Maxigum kill of weeds will be obtained from spring or

early fall application when where are actively growing. Avoid applyiff: uring inng excessively dry or
not periods united: nquisterrillation is evallable. If
applications fill a when soil is quite warm, use reduced rates to reduce potential injury. Do not irrigate
within 24 hours of application. Do not apply to newly
seeded turf until after the second or third mowing.
Seed can be safely sown 3 to 4 weeks after application at recommended rate. Do not use on dichandra.

If dandelicns persist as a special problem, individual spot treatment with a single nozzle hand sprayer is recommended. Do not overdose Bentgrass. In closely mowed Bentgrass (pritting and bowling greens) apply Bentgrass Fermula at a maximum rate of 1 fluid once per 1,000 square feet preferably in May, or through September. Any yellowing will disappear after about one week.

For hard-to-kill summer weeds, use 6 pints per acre. Do not apply this rate to benigrass, centipede or St. Augustine grasses.

NOTE: Care should be taken to avoid overdosing Benigrass or injury may result. Large volumes of spray water will aid in obtaining uniform coverage. If hand type sprayers are user it is preferable to use a single nozzle sprayer rath, then a multiple nozzle boom as sideways application with a boom where the spray from more than one nozzle is allowed to fall on the same area will risult in heavy local overapplication and subsequent turf discoloration or injury.

WEEDS CONTROLLED: Bentgrass Fermule is esspecially effective against weeds such as SHEEP SORREL, KNOTWEED, SPOTTED SPURGE, CHICK-WEED, OXALIS AND HENBIT. In addition to these, it kills virtually all broadlesf weeds, some of which are listed below.
