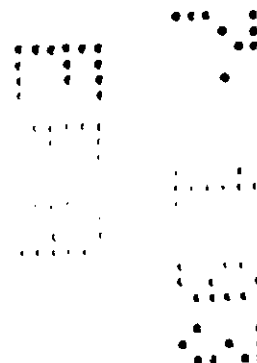

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

DANGER: Corrosive, causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear long pants, long-sleeved shirt, shoes and gloves when mixing, loading or applying this product. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower.

Containers over 1 gallon and less than 5 gallons: Persons engaged in open pouring of this product must also wear coveralls or a chemical resistant apron.

Containers of 5 gallons or more: A mechanical system (probe and pump) must be used for transferring the contents of this container. If the contents of a non-refillable pesticide container are emptied, the probe must be rinsed before removal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Drift or runoff may adversely affect aquatic invertebrates and nontarget plants. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Do not contaminate domestic or irrigation waters. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from target area. Most cases of groundwater contamination involving phenoxy herbicides such as 2,4-D and MCPP have been associated with mixing/loading and disposal sites. Placement of the mixing/loading equipment on an impervious pad to contain spills will help prevent groundwater contamination.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use on residential and other turf sites excluding sod farms.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried or dust has settled.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. OTHER USE PRECAUTIONS:

1. Avoid drift of spray mist onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants.
2. Do not pour spray solution near these plants.
3. Do not spray on carpetgrass, dichondra or lawns or turf where desirable clovers are present.
4. Use only lawn-type sprayers.
5. NOTE: Coarse sprays are less likely to wind-drift.
6. Do not spray roots of trees and ornamentals. Do not exceed specified dosages for any area; be particularly careful within dripline of trees and other ornamental species.
7. Do not spray while grass is emerging from dormancy.
8. Do not apply to newly seeded grasses until well established.
9. Do not apply when air temperature exceeds 85°F.
10. Seed can be sown 3 to 4 weeks after application.
11. Do not contaminate domestic or irrigation waters.
12. Some injury can be expected to turf when used on centipede or St. Augustine grasses.
13. After using this product, clean sprayer with soap or detergent and water, and rinse thoroughly before applying other pesticides.
14. Failure to observe the above precautions may result in injury.
15. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

ORNAMENTAL LAWNS & TURF (Other than bentgrass): Apply at the rate of 2 to 3 pints per acre in sufficient water for adequate coverage. Use the higher rate in heavy weed growth or on older weeds, or, during periods of poor growth. Maximum weed control will be obtained from spring or early fall application when weeds are actively growing. Spray when average temperatures are 50°F or higher. Avoid applying during long, excessively dry or hot periods unless adequate irrigation can be supplied. Do not irrigate within 24 hours of application. Do not apply to newly seeded turf until after the second or third mowing. Grass seed can be sown 3 to 4 weeks after application at recommended rate. Do not use on dichondra, carpetgrass or St. Augustinegrass.

The maximum application rate to turf is 1.0 pound 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.

BENTGRASS TURF: In closely-mowed bentgrass (putting and bowling greens) apply at a maximum rate of 1/2 fluid ounce per 1,000 square feet preferably in May, or mid-August through September. Slight turf yellowing will disappear after about one week.

NOTE: Care should be taken to avoid overdosing bentgrass or injury may result. Large volumes of spray water (i.e. 1 gallon per 250 or 300 square feet) will aid in obtaining uniform coverage. If hand-type sprayers are used, it is best to use a single nozzle sprayer rather than a multiple nozzle boom. Sweeping movements with a multiple nozzle boom will result in heavy local over-application and subsequent turf discoloration or injury.
