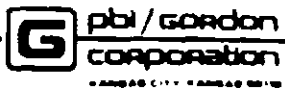
Avoid drift of spray mist to vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants.

For most spray solutions on desirable plants, Dr. Williams' can be applied in the early morning or late afternoon when temperatures are in the 60's or 70's, and where there are no covers present. Use only an atomizer sprayer. Avoid the sprays, coarse sprays are essential in wind drift. Do not spray roots of ornamentals and trees. Do not exceed specified dosages. Use a fine, fan pattern spray carefully within the drip line of trees and shrubs. Do not spray seedlings or young plants. Do not spray ornamental seedlings. Do not spray tomatoes, cucumbers, grasses or cereals. Do not spray after a hard frost. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 80 degrees F. Do not spray when wind is blowing. After application, do not water plants. Do not expect the material used on certain plants in August to last through the summer. Do not spray ornamentals or trees. Do not spray grasses and possible damage there and to certain ornamentals. Do not spray after using this product on a clean sprayer with soap or detergent and rinse thoroughly before using on other pesticides and mixtures.
