**ASPARAGUS** - To control Asparagus Beetle and Apache Cicada. Do not repeat application within three days. Do not treat within one day of harvest.

**BEANS** - (Green Beans, Lima Beans, Snap Beans, Cowpeas, Black-eyed): To control Mexican Bean Beetle, Bean Leaf Beetle, Cucumber Beetles, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetle, Leafhoppers, Velvetbean Caterpillar, Western Bean Cutworm, Armyworms, Corn Earworm, Stink Bugs and Tarnish Plant Bugs.

**SWEET CORN** - To control Corn Earworm, Corn Rootworm adults, European Corn Borer, Fall Armyworm, Flea Beetles, Japanese Beetles, Sap Beetles, and Leafhoppers. For larvae in Whorl (budworm damage) and foliage feeders, apply to entire plant. Repeat as necessary.

For insects attacking silks and ears, apply at 2 to 3 day intervals starting when first silks begin to dry. Three or more applications may be required depending on severity of infestation. Timing and good coverage are essential for effective control.

**CUCUMBER, MELONS, PUMPKIN, SQUASH** - To control Pickleworm, Melonworm, Cucumber Beetles, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers and Squash Bugs. Avoid excessive applications. Some leaf injury may occur if treatments are made when tender foliage is wet or in the presence of prolonged high humidity. Do not use on watermelons in Florida.

**POTATO, TOMATO, EGGPLANT, PEPPER** - To control Colorado Potato Beetle, Flea Beetles, Leafhoppers, European Corn Borer, Fall Armyworm, Lace Bugs, Tomato Fruit Worm, Tomato Hornworm, Tamish Plant Bugs, Stink Bugs.

**HEAD LETTUCE AND CARROTS** - To control Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bug, Leafhoppers, Armyworms, Cabbage Caterpillars, Corn Earworms, Spittlebugs, Tarnished Plant Bugs and Stink Bugs. To control small Cabbage Loopers use on a 5 to 7 day schedule.

**CABBAGE, BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CAULIFLOWER, KOHLRABI** - To control Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bugs, Armyworms, Cabbage Caterpillars, Corn Earworms. To control small Cabbage Loopers use on a 5 to 7 day schedule.

#### INSECT CONTROL ON SMALL FRUIT

**STRAWBERRIES** - To control Meadow Spittlebugs, Strawberry Leaf Roller and Strawberry Weevil. Do not apply within one day of harvest.

#### TO CONTROL GRASSHOPPERS ON THE ABOVE CROPS
