PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors dust. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash-thoroughly-after-handling.

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF-SWALLOWED: Induce vomiting and seek medical-attention immediately.

IF IN EYES OR ON SKIN: Flush eyes thoroughly with water; wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use 2-PAM, opiates or cholinesterase inhibiting drugs.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. For terrestrial-uses,— Do not apply directly to water. or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.— Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or animals. Keep in cool, dry place.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

Apply Sevin® Dust 5% when insects or their damage appear.

Make applications to plants in the morning or evening when it is cool. Treat upper and lower surface
of all foliage for complete coverage. Repeat as necessary, generally at 7 day intervals. For best
results apply with a dust gun. Do not apply in excess.

 Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, use a dust applicator such as a shaker can, dust gun, puffer or other bulbous duster, rotary duster or other appropriate duster as available. Dust lightly to cover both upper and lower leaf surfaces with a thin, even film of dust.

Apply when air is calm to avoid drift and contact with eyes and skin.

 Start applying at the farthest comer of the treatment area and work backward to avoid contact with dusted surfaces. Allow dust to settle in treated areas before reentering.

For plants above chest height, consider using a liquid carbaryl product.

Do not repeat application more than once a week.

 Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated soil must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl labels.

INSECT CONTROL ON VEGETABLES

Asparagus: To control Asparagus Beetle and Apache Cicada. Do not repeat-application within three days. Do not treat within one day of harvest.

Beans (Green Beans, Lima Beans, Snap Beans, Cowpeas, Black-eyed): To control Mexican bean beetle, bean leaf beetle, cucumber beetle, flea beetle, Japanese beetle, leafhoppers, velvetbean caterpillar, Western bean cutworm, armyworm, corn earworm, grasshoppers, stink bugs and tarnish plant bug.

Sweet Corn: To control corn earworm, corn rootworm adults, European corn borer, fall armyworm, flea beetle, Japanese beetle, sap beetle, grasshoppers; and leafhoppers. For larvae in Whorl (budworm damage) and foliage feeders, apply to entire plant. Repeat as necessary.

For insects attacking silks and ears, apply at 2-to 3 day intervals starting when first silks begin to dry. Three or more applications may be required depending on severity of infestation. Timing and good coverage are essential for effective control.

Cucumber, Melons, Pumpkin, Squash: To control pickleworm, melonworm, cucumber beetle, flea beetle, leafhoppers, grasshoppers; and squash bug. Avoid excessive applications. Some leaf injury may occur if treatments are made when tender foliage is wet or in the presence of prolonged high humidity. Do not use on watermelons in Florida.

Potato, Tomato, Eggplant, Pepper: To control Colorado potato beetle, flea beetle, leafhoppers, European com borer, fall armyworm, lace bug, tomato fruitworm, tomato hornworm, grasshoppers, tamish plant bug, stink bugs.

Head Lettuce and Carrots: To control flea beetle, harlequin bug, leafhoppers, armyworm, cabbage caterpillar, corn earworm, spittlebug, grasshoppers, tamished plant bug and stink bugs. To control cabbage looper use on a-5-to 7 day schedule. Allow three (3) days between dusting and harvesting for head lettuce. Allow fourteen (14) days between dusting and harvest for leaf lettuce.

Cabbage, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cauliflower, Kohirabi: To control flea beetle, harlequin bug, armyworm, cabbage caterpillar, grasshoppers, and com earworm. To control cabbage looper use on a 5 to 7 day schedule. Allow three (3) days between dusting and harvesting.

Note for Vegetables: Injury to young tender foliage may occur if plants are wet or in the presence of high humidity for several days duration following treatment.

INSECT CONTROL ON SMALL FRUIT

Strawberries: To control meadow spittlebug, strawberry leaf roller and strawberry weevil. Do-not-apply within one day of harvest. Allow 1 day between dusting and harvest of Strawberries.

TO CONTROL GRASSHOPPERS ON THE ABOVE CROPS

Apply Sevin* Dust 5% as often as necessary on crops to control grasshoppers. On Asparagus follow cautions noted above:

IMPORTANT NOTE: Allow 1-day between dusting and harvest of Strawberries.—Three-days on Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Head Lettuce and Kahirabi. Do not use on Leaf Lettuce within 14-days of harvest, injury to young tender-foliage may occur if plants are wet or in the presence of high humidity of several days duration following treatment.

POULTRY-(Chickens, Turkeys, Ducks, Geese, Game-Birds, Pigeons)

Application of 5% Sevin® Dust-to-poultry for control of chicken-mites and fleas is to be make as a supplement to litter treatment for control of these pests:

On birds: Northern fowl mite, chicken mite, lice, fleas 1 pound 5% dust per 100 birds.

On litter: Northern fowl mite, chicken mite, lice, fleas, bedbugs 1-pound-5%-dust-per 40 square feet. Dust-bath boxes: Northern fewl mite, chicken mite, lice and fleas 2 1/2 pounds 5%-dust-per box for each 50 birds.

DO NOT APPLY 7 days before slaughter. Do not treat nest litter. Avoid-direct-contamination of eggs. Tolerance 5 ppm. on meat and fat, 0 in eggs.

ON-DOGS AND CATS

Brown dog tick, fleas: rub in skin and apply in-sleeping-quarters weekly. Do not treat kitten-and-puppies under-4-weeks old. Do not-use on pregnant dogs.
