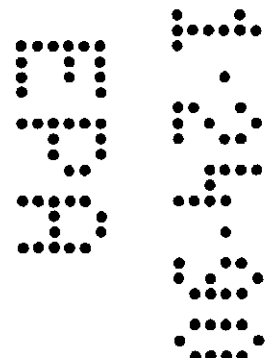

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets. Keep from freezing.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

**FOG FOR FLYING INSECTS:**

Use compressed air or fog generator to dispense Pyrenone Spray into atmosphere as a fine mist. For house flies, mosquitoes and gnats in food processing establishments, or Indian Meal Moth and Angumois Moth in grain storage or processing plants, use at the rate of 3 ounces per 3,000 cubic feet (1 quart per 30,000 cubic feet). Doors, windows and outside ventilators must be closed to contain mist for 20 to 30 minutes. Repeat treatment as needed. Remove animals or pets during operation and ventilate before reoccupying.

**FOR CRAWLING INSECTS:**

For control of cockroaches, silverfish, carpet beetles and ants, best results are obtained by using a coarse mist spray directed on the insects. Thoroughly spray all cracks and crevices where the insects could hide, particularly in areas where plumbing is installed. Ant trails should be sprayed. For carpet beetles make liberal and repeated applications to baseboards, infested carpets, infested furniture, corners and under furniture.

**FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS:**

Use this product only as a contact spray in food processing plants and only when plant is not in operation. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using. Vacate treated ares and ventilate before re-occupying.

**STORED GRAINS:**

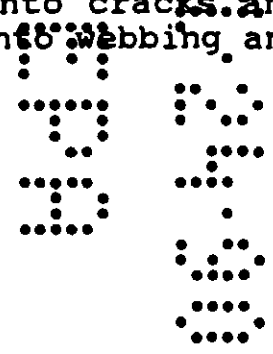
Apply 1 gallon to 1,500 square feet - directly to the grain surface as an aid in the control of granary and rice weevils, sawtooth grain beetle, confused flour beetle, cadelle, mealworms, and the larvae of the Indian meal moth and the Mediterranean flour moth, that are feeding on or near the surface of the grain. Make one or more applications, or as needed throughout the storage period.

**MILLS AND WAREHOUSES:**

Spray empty bins thoroughly as well as boots, conveyors, floors, or any place where debris accumulates. Follow good housekeeping practices of heavy-duty vacuuming and cleaning, and then thoroughly spray premises. Planned applications of Pyrenone Spray between fumigations will greatly reduce Granary Weevil, Indian Meal Moth or Confused Flour Beetle.

**GRAIN STORAGE BINS:**

Spray empty bins, floors and conveyors liberally. Use a sprayer to deliver a coarse spray and direct the spray into cracks and crevices, under pallets, around machinery bases, on to webbing and hiding areas where insects may rest or harbor.
