Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Induce vomiting and seek medical attention immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use 2-PAM, opiates, or cholinesterase inhibiting drugs.

Environmental Hazards:

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep from freezing. Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or animals. Do not store in areas where temperatures frequently exceed 100°F.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: For Plastic Containers - Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed, by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke. For Metal Containers - Triple rinse (or equivalent). ROSES, FLOWERS, ORNAMENTALS, SHRUBS & SHADE TREES: Mix 4 teaspoonfuls of LIQUID SEVIN SPRAY per finished gallon of spray, 1 1/4 pints per each 30 gallons, or 2 1/2 pints per each 60 gallons of spray. Treat at first sign of insect damage. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals, or as necessary to maintain control. Wet all leaf surfaces thoroughly. Do not use on Boston Ivy as injury may result.

Roses: Thrips (exposed), Roseslug, Japanese beetle, Rose aphids, and Leafrollers.

Flowers & Shrubs: Japanese beetle, Boxelder bug, Tent caterpillars, Lace bugs, Leafrollers, and Leafhoppers.

Shade Trees: Bagworms, Elm leaf beetle, Birchleaf miner, Boxelder bug, Tent caterpillars, Periodical cicadas, and Leafhoppers.

Shrubbery, Hedges & Flowerbeds: Mosquitoes (Adult). Spray where mosquitoes may rest during the day.

TURF: Mow grass and water before spraying. Use one pint of LIQUID SEVIN SPRAY in 15 gallons of water. Apply to 1,250 square feet of turf to control Chinch bugs, Sod webworms (lawn moth), Fall armyworms, Cutworms, Earwigs, Fleas, and Ants. Repeat in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary.
