The Agency is conditionally approving an amendment to the registration of the abovereferenced product under the authority of section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). Under this amendment the Agency is approving the conversion of the active ingredient mecoprop from its racemic form [2-(2-methyl-4-chlorophenoxy) propionic acid, or applicable salt thereof] to its single isomer form [(+)-R-2-(2-methyl-4-chlorophenoxy) propionic acid, or applicable salt thereof]. The revised labeling and Confidential Statement(s) of Formula submitted in support of the conversion are acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1. This acceptance is based on your certification that no changes have been made to the Confidential Statement(s) of Formula (CSF) or the product labeling other than those specified within the body of your certification statement. No other revisions are being reviewed or considered with this action.
- 2. You may sell or distribute product containing the racemic form of mecoprop and bearing the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter.

A copy of the revised Confidential Statement of Formula (Basic Formulation, dated 08/14/98) has been placed in the Agency's file for the subject product. This CSF supersedes all previously submitted CSFs for this product.

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

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals

This product can only be used to formulate pesticide products if the labeling contains the following information and/or revised use directions. All products manufactured for residential and turf uses after June 15, 1994, must contain the revised label language below.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR END-USE PRODUCT LABELING

- Containers over 1 gallon and less than 5 gallons in capacity must bear the following statement: "Persons engaged in open pouring of this product must also wear coveralls or a chemical resistant apron."
- 2 Containers of 5 gallons or more in capacity must also bear the following statement: "A mechanical system (probe and pump) must be used for transferring the contents of this container. If the contents of a non-refillable pesticide container are emptied, the probe must be rinsed before removal."

Clothing Requirement Statements: 1) For All Granular Products: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes." 2) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by homeowners and other noncommercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course; acid, sodium salt and ester products applied in liquid form and carrying "CAUTION" signal word only must bear the following language: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves. 3) Products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) by homeowners and other noncommercial users, and for commercial mixer/loader/applicators when the product is to be applied to a golf course; acid, sodium sate and ester products applied in liquid form and carrying "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word only must bear the following language: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and ester products applied in liquid form and carrying "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word only must bear the following language: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, brow and temple protection.
- b. Personal Hygiene Statements: 1) For All Granular Products: "After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water." 2) For All Liquid Products: "After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower."
- c. The maximum application rate to turf is the lower of: 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) Two pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.
- d. The following reentry statement must be included: "Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment area until spray has dried or dust has settled."

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law and may contaminate groundwater.
