PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals:
DANGER—Corrosive. causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. If in eyes, see a physician. 1. Avoid drift of spray mist onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants.
2. Do not pour spray solutions near these plants.
3. Do not use on bentgrass, carpetgrass, dichondra or St. Augustine lawns.
4. Do not spray roots of trees and ornamentals. Do not exceed specified dosages for any area. Be particularly careful with n-dipole of tree and other ornamental species.
5. NOTE: Coarse sprays are less likely to wind-drift.
6. Do not spray while grass is emerging from dormancy.
7. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns until after the second or third mowing.

If In Eyes:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont.)

8. Do not spray when air temperature exceeds 85° F.
9. Seed can be safely sown 3 to 4 weeks after application.
10. Do not contaminate domestic or irrigation waters.
11. After using this product, clean sprayer with soap or detergent and water, and rinse thoroughly before applying other pesticides.
12. Failure to observe the above precautions may result in injury.

NOTE: Do not use on bentgrass, carpetgrass, dichondra or St. Augustine lawns.

ORNAMENTAL LAWNS & TURF:

Apply Gordon's 2,4-D/Dicamba Turf Herbicide at the rate of 1 to 2 pints per acre in 20 to 160 gallons of water. Maximum kill of weeds will be obtained from spring or early fall application when plants are actively growing. Avoid applying during long, excessively dry or hot periods unless adequate irrigation is available. Do not irrigate within 24 hours of application. Do not apply to newly seeded turf until after 1st, 2nd or 3rd mowing. Grass seed can be safely sown 3 to 4 weeks after application at recommended rate.
