The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1) We have noted that this product allows formulations for residential and turf uses only. The following changes should be made accordingly:
 - a) Add the statement "To be formulated into herbicides for residential and turf uses only."
 - Delete the sentence "All other products (i.e., agricultural, industrial and aquatic) manufactured after October 23, 1993 must bear the revised label language below" from the Directions for Use.
- Under the Specific Requirements for End-Use Product Labeling for Residential and Turf Uses, add the following statement:

For Amine Liquid Products carrying "CAUTION" signal word: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and rubber gloves."

Change the second sentence of the Pesticide Disposal statement to read "Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous."

Personal Hygiene Statements: 1) For All Granular Products: "After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water." 2) For All Liquid Products: "After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower."
