6 Lb. Amine 2,4-D Herbicide Manufacturing Concentrate
EPA Registration No. 2217-665
Your Submission Dated October 21, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1) The Active Ingredients heading should be made singular.
- 2) We have noted that this product allows formulations for residential and turf uses only. The following changes should be made accordingly:
 - a) Add the statement "To be formulated into herbicides for residential and turf uses only."
 - b) Delete the sentence "All other products (i.e., agricultural, industrial and aquatic) manufactured after October 23, 1993 must bear the revised label language below" from the Directions for Use.
- 3) Under the Specific Requirements for End-Use Product Labeling for Residential and Turf Uses, add the following statement:

For Amine Liquid Products carrying "CAUTION" signal word:
"When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and rubber gloves."
- 4) Change the second sentence of the Pesticide Disposal statement to read "Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous."

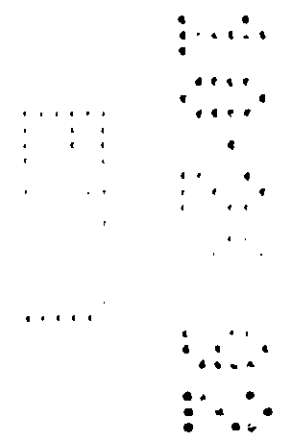

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER: Corrosive, causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. If eye exposure occurs, get immediate medical attention. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapor. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: In case of contact, immediately flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Call a physician at once.

IF ON SKIN: Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water. Induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Call a physician at once. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Instructions must be followed in strict accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations for formulating use.

This product can only be used to formulate pesticide products if the labeling contains the following information and/or revised use directions. All products manufactured for residential and turf uses after June 15, 1994, must contain the revised label language below. All other products (i.e., agricultural, industrial and aquatic), manufactured after October 23, 1993 must bear the revised label language below.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR END-USE PRODUCT LABELING

1. Containers over 1 gallon and less than 5 gallons in capacity must bear the following statement: "Persons engaged in open pouring of this product must also wear coveralls or a chemical resistant apron."
2. Containers of 5 gallons or more in capacity must also bear the following statement: "A mechanical system (probe and pump) must be used for transferring the contents of this container. If the contents of a non-refillable pesticide container are emptied, the probe must be rinsed before removal."

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR END-USE PRODUCT LABELING

3. FOR RESIDENTIAL AND TURF USES

- a. Clothing Requirement Statements: 1) For All Granular Products: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes." 2) For Amine Liquid Products Carrying "WARNING" or "DANGER" signal word: "When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, rubber gloves and eye protection. It is recommended that safety glasses include front, side and temple protection."
- b. Personal Hygiene Statements: 1) For All Granular Products: "After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water." 2) For All Liquid Products: "After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower."

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- c. The maximum application rate to turf is the lower of 1) existing application rate on currently registered label or 2) 2 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.
 - d. The following reentry statement must be included: "Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried or dust has settled."

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets. Keep from freezing. To prevent cross-contamination, do not store near other herbicides, fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, or near seeds.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate, is a violation of Federal Law and may contaminate groundwater. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: FOR METAL CONTAINERS - Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures.
