Drift: MECOME 4 is a selective herbicide. Do not spray in windy weather as the spray drift may cause damage to neighboring crops. Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure beans, tomatoes, peas, alfalfa, clover and cattails; grapes, sugar beets, tobacco, corn, sunflowers, kale, elder trees, as well as flowers, ornamentals and shrubs. **COARSE SPRAYS ARE LESS LIKELY TO WIND DRIFT.**

Equipment: Wash equipment thoroughly with water and a wetting agent or detergent immediately after use. Spray out, fill with clean water and leave overnight. Spray out again before storing or using for another product. Trace of the product remaining in the sprayer may cause harm to susceptible plants.

Statement of Practical Treatment

When to Apply: Make applications on a warm, clear day when weeds are growing vigorously. For the best results, MECOME 4 must be applied when weeds are most susceptible and conditions are such that no damage to grasses will occur. During periods of drought, weeds become more resistant to herbicides. Under these same conditions, fine grasses are more susceptible to MECOME 4, particularly when temperatures exceed 90 degrees F. MECOME 4 is absorbed by the foliage of broadleaf weeds and is translocated throughout the whole plant to the roots where it eventually causes the death of the plant.

DO NOT Do not cut or mow grasses 7 to 10 days before or after treatment so that maximum uptake and translocation can occur. Do not spray if rain is expected to fall within the period. Rain may wash off the product. Do not take water from the same source. Do not water grass for 24 hours after application. MECOME 4 is not recommended for use on strike and bentgrass lawns. Do not use MECOME 4 on newly sown lawns or golf courses within 60 days after planting. Do not use the first cuttings as a mulch for lawns and vegetables.

In established grasses such as lawns, other turf grasses and home lawns, use 1 to 2 oz. per 1,000 square feet, 3 to 4 pints per acre, in 3 quarts of water per 1,000 square feet, 32 to 40 quarts per acre.

In established greens, apply 1/2 to 1 oz. per 1,000 square feet, 2 pints to 2 1/2 pints per acre, in 3 quarts of water per 1,000 square feet, 32 to 40 quarts per acre.

NOTE: Use sprayer calibration equipment to check application rate. Do not apply more than 1.5 quarts per 1,000 square feet per acre per year.
