Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

Where to Use:

This contact fungicide provides disease control in cool season and warm season turfgrass established in these sites only:

- golf course tees, greens, collars, and aprons
- as a spot treatment on fairways (maximum 5% of fairway area)
- athletic fields used only by professional athletes

Prohibitions:

Do not apply this product on these sites:

- · residential lawns and residential turf
- lawns and turf at parks and schools
- Do not graze or feed clippings from treated areas to livestock.

Limitations for use:

- The maximum number of applications is limited to 6 per year: 4 applications at 4 ounces/1000 sq.ft. [7 lb ai/A] and 2 applications at 9 ounces/1000 sq.ft. [16 lb ai/A].
- The maximum seasonal rate is 34 ounces of product per 1000 sq.ft. per year [60 lb ai/A/year]
- Observe [follow or use] a minimum retreatment interval of 14 days between applications.
- Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Turf Diseases

Snow Mold - For the control of snow mold (Typhula spp.), apply 6 to 9 ounces of Teremec® SP per 1,000 square feet in sufficient water to give complete coverage, usually 3 to 5 gallons per 1,000 square feet. Apply as a spray as late in the fall as possible prior to snowfall.

Pythium Blight - For control of pythium blight on established turf, apply Teremec® SP as a preventative treatment at 4 ounces per 1,000 square feet in 3 to 5 gallons of water. Apply during periods of high temperature and humidity favorable to the development of disease. Repeat in 14 days if conditions persists.

For the control of pythium blight on new seedlings, apply Teremec® SP at 4 ounces per 1,000 square feet following emergence. If conditions remain favorable to the development of disease, repeat in 14 days.

Southern Blight - For control of southern blight (Sclerotium rolfsii) on established turf, apply Teremec® SP as a preventative treatment at 4 ounces per 1,000 square feet in 3 to 5 gallons of water. Apply during periods of high temperature and humidity favorable to the development of disease. Repeat in 14 days if conditions persist.

For the control of sclerotium blight on new seedlings, apply Teremec® SP at 4 ounces per 1,000 square feet following emergence. If conditions remain favorable to the development of disease, repeat in 14 days.

Brown Patch (Rhizoctonia Blight) - For warm season turf (such as zoysiagrass, St. Augustinegrass, bermudagrass and similar grasses) apply in the fall or spring at the first signs of infection. Mix 5 ounces Teremec® SP in 10 to 15 gallons of water to thoroughly cover 1,000 square feet. Make a second application in 3 to 4 weeks if the disease is severe or reappears.

For cool season turf (such as creeping bentgrass, annual bluegrass, fescue and similar grasses) apply at first signs of infection. Mix 3 to 4 ounces Teremec® SP in 3 to 5 gallons of water to thoroughly cover 1,000 square feet. Reapply every 14 days during warm, damp weather.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on-site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
