NOTIFICATION:

1. The revisions of the disposal instructions per Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 2001-6 were previously approved on April 15, 2003. To be consistent with the guidance of PRN 2001-6, we ask to remove the phrase, "Wrap in newspaper..." Please refer to page 2 of the labeling.
2. We propose to change the Ingredient Statement to read "OTHER INGREDIENTS", rather than "INERT INGREDIENTS", in accordance with Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 97-6.
3. We ask to change the mixing directions for perennial weed which do not affect the dilution ratio or the minimum or maximum use dilutions. Please refer to page 3 of the labeling.
4. We ask to add five (5) advertising claims which may be presented on the retail containers of supplemental registrants. (Refer to page 5 of the enclosed labeling).

One copy of the revised label is enclosed for your review.


This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or Confidential Statement of Formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to the EPA. Vegetation Killer 250 is a nonselective product intended for use after dilution with water, or an appropriate oil, or other approved carrier. For best results, apply to bare ground or when weed growth is just starting. Weeds taller than 4 to 6 inches should be hoed before treatment or it may be necessary to make a second application. A second application may be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds. Use for bare ground vegetation control in driveways, brick walks, paths, patios, parking areas, play areas, along fences and curbs, around buildings, and under graveled pathways where plant growth has come through these surfaces.

For control of annual and susceptible perennial weeds such as downy brome grass, oatgrass, goosegrass, quackgrass, puncturevine, goldenrod, and plantain. To cover 100 square feet, add (apply) 1 to 1½ pints by use of a sprinkling can or other watering or spraying device in sufficient water to get good coverage of the area (e.g. 2½ gallons in sprinkling can).

For control of hard-to-kill perennial broadleaf and grass weeds such as bindweed and Johnson grass as well as the biennials common mullein and wild carrot. To cover 25 square feet, add (apply) 1 pint to 1 pint 6 fl. oz. by use of a sprinkler can or other watering or spraying device in sufficient water to get good coverage (e.g. 2½ qts, (or 5 pints) in sprinkling can).

Different grades of mineral oil, diesel fuel, petroleum based oil, fuel oil, or kerosene may be substituted for water.

When using a sprinkling can, triple rinse and pour rinsate on area treated once application is completed. Mix only the quantity needed and use immediately. Do not store diluted solution once container is opened. To minimize lateral movement, sprinkle lightly with a watering can or similar sprinkler device immediately after application.
