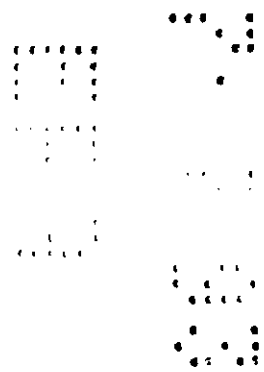

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

STORAGE and DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store product in original container in locked storage area, inaccessible to children and pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

GENERAL INFORMATION: EMBARK 1-L Plant Growth Regulator (PGR) is recommended for use in public, commercial, and industrial areas for regulating the growth of various species of turf grasses and broadleaf vegetation. EMBARK 1-L PGR reduces mowing requirements for up to 8 weeks following treatment by regulating growth and suppressing seedhead formation.

SPRAY EQUIPMENT: EMBARK 1-L PGR may be applied to localized areas with small spray units, such as backpack sprayers, or to larger areas with conventional spray equipment. To be assured of proper dosage and uniform spray coverage it is essential that spray equipment is properly calibrated. When calibrating with small spray equipment, a trial application is recommended over a small measured turf area. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

MIXING: Pour the required amount of EMBARK 1-L PGR into the spray tank containing approximately 1/2 the required amount of water. Fill the tank as required with water and spray as recommended. Minimal agitation in the spray tank is necessary since the 1-L formulation is soluble in water.

RINSING: Rinse EMBARK 1-L PGR container with water and pour the rinse solution into the spray tank prior to spraying. Do not use spray equipment for other purposes until thoroughly cleaned. Flush spray equipment with plenty of water immediately after use to avoid contamination of later sprays.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION

Apply EMBARK 1-L PGR uniformly to green, actively growing turf. At the time of treatment, turf should be at the height which is desired to be maintained during the period of growth regulation. For season long seedhead suppression of cool season grasses apply no later than when the seedhead can be felt at the base of the stem. (Approximately 2 weeks prior to seedhead appearance.) Do not apply to closely mowed areas where most of the green growth has been cut. Turf may be mowed up to 1 day before or 3 to 7 days after application. Remove all grass clippings and leaves prior to treatment. Avoid spray overlaps that will increase dosage above those recommended. EMBARK 1-L PGR may be applied twice per season on Kentucky bluegrass, fescues, and Bermudagrass; however, an interval of at least 6 weeks should occur before the second application. Use the higher rate of application where the greatest growth regulation and seedhead suppression are desired.

RECOMMENDED USE AREAS: EMBARK 1-L PGR applied uniformly as a broadcast spray to turf will reduce mowing requirements for up to 8 weeks in the following commercial and public areas:

Commercial-Industrial: Highway Rights-of-way, Utility Rights-of-way, Buildings, Industrial Parks, Tank Farms, Airports.

Public: Schools, Libraries, Hospitals, Cemeteries, Golf Courses, Parks, Roads and Walkways.

Tank Mixing with 2,4-D or Mecoprop (MCP): EMBARK 1-L PGR may be tank mixed with up to 2.0 lbs. active ingredient per acre of 2,4-D in low volatility ester and amine salt formulations of MCP in amine salt formulations. Follow the instructions and precautionary statements on the 2,4-D and MCP product labels.

EMBARK 1-L PGR should not be applied to golf greens.

Do not apply EMBARK 1-L PGR to turf areas within 4 growing months after seeding and do not reseed within 2 weeks following application. Do not allow animals to graze on treated areas. Optimum results may not be obtained if rainfall or overhead irrigation occurs within 8 hours following application.
