GENERAL INFORMATION

Manage[®] CB is an industrial turf growth regulator. This product will regulate the growth and development of listed cool-season grasses. Application of this product in accordance with this label will reduce grass growth for up to six weeks and suppress or eliminate emergence of seedheads. This product does not control weeds. Use this product with appropriate herbicides when necessary to control weeds.

When applied as directed under the conditions described, this product will regulate the growth and development of the following cool-season turf-grass species:

- Kentucky Bluegrass
Poa pratensis
- Tall and Fine Fescues
Festuca spp.
- Perennial Ryegrass
Lolium perenne

This product is recommended for use in industrial rights-of-way (highway, railroad, pipeline, utility), fence rows, ditchbanks and industrial sites.

Caution is advised in spraying around or over ornamentals and flowers. Avoid treatment of areas subject to heavy use.

Following treatment, keep people and domestic animals off treated vegetation until foliage has dried.

Do not allow domestic animals to feed or forage on treated areas. Do not use grass clippings for animal feed or mulching of fruit and vegetables. Grass clippings may be used for mulching around trees or ornamental shrubs not used for food production. Mulch should not be used in flower beds or other areas where plants are grown from seeds or annual flowers are transplanted.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PREGREENUP TREATMENT — Applications of this product in early spring prior to or during initial turf greenup can expand the normal application window. Treatments prior to full greenup will delay further greenup and reduce or eliminate emergence of seedheads.

FULL GREENUP TREATMENT — Apply this product to green and actively growing turfgrass after it has developed the desired appearance. For suppression of seedheads, application should be made before seedheads begin to emerge. Treatments made after seedheads begin to emerge will not suppress development of seedheads. For best results after seedhead emergence, first mow off old seedheads and allow time for regrowth of new tillers before applications of this product.

Applications may be made before or after mowing. Delay mowing after application until rainfall (0.25 inches or more) has washed this product to the soil surface. Avoid applications to turfgrass under stress conditions until active turf growth has resumed.

If an extended growth suppression period is desired, a repeat application at recommended rates may be made to actively growing turfgrass 6 to 8 weeks after the first application. Sequential applications made too quickly after the first application, or preceding periods of reduced growth due to heat or drought, may lead to turf thinning due to excessive growth suppression.

APPLICATION RATES

For reduced vegetative growth and seedhead control or suppression of listed turfgrass species, apply 2.5 quarts of this product per acre in 15 or more gallons of water per acre.

To be effective, this product must reach the soil and be taken up by the roots of the plant. For best results, moderate rainfall (0.25 inches or more) should occur within 5 days following application and before the first mowing to ensure the product is washed off the leaves.

Do not apply this product with aerial application equipment.
