While we encourage its use elsewhere on the label, the term "DEET" must be deleted from the active ingredient label declaration.

Although we would prefer inclusion, we have determined that it is acceptable to remove the statement, "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you". You may remove this statement from your label without submitting an amendment.
