### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Do not inhale dust. Do not allow contact with skin, eyes or clothing. When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:**

Drift or runoff may adversely affect nontarget plants. ### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For use on ornamental lawns and turf established in institutional, ornamental, and residential sites. Grass seed crops and sod farms uses are excluded. Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

### WHERE TO USE:

Gordon's Tri-Guard is a Trimec<sup>®</sup> brand herbicide containing fertilizer, 2,4-D, mecoprop, and didamba. This granular weed and feed provides a balanced supply of plant nutrients and controls a broad spectrum of broadleaf weeds in turfgrass. Supplemental nitrogen, phosphorus, and potash should be applied according to soil tests or State Extension Service recommendations.

Gordon's Tri-Guard is intended to be applied by commercial applicators, noncommercial users, lawn care operators, and landscape personnel. Cool season and warm season grasses established in institutional, ornamental, and residential sites may be treated.

Institutional sites are defined as turf areas around properties or facilities providing a service to public or private organizations; for example, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, museums, libraries, sport facilities (including golfcourses), and office buildings may be treated. Omamental sites include turfgrass established around residences, parks, streets, retail outlets, cemeteries, and institutional buildings. Finally, residential sites are defined as areas associated with the household or home life including, but not limited to apartment complexes, condominiums, and patient care areas of nursing homes, mental institutions, hospitals, or convalescent homes.

Gordon's Tri-Guard may be applied to newly seeded cool season turfgrass. Applications are recommended only after the third mowing or after the grass seedlings have tillered and have developed an adequate secondary root system.

Gordon's Tri-Guard may be applied to newly established warm season turfgrass. Treatments should be delayed until 3 - 4 weeks after the sodding, sprigging, or plugging operations, and low application rates (½ of the recommendation for established turfgrass) are suggested.

A uniform broadcast distribution of product on the treated area is essential. Do not exceed the specified application rate for any area; use care in the application of this product within the dripline of trees, shrubs, and other ornamentals.

Do not use this product on dichondra, carpetgrass, St. Augustinegrass, closely-mowed bentgrass putting greens, or turf containing desirable clovers.

### WEEDS CONTROLLED:

Dandelion, chickweed, plantain, and clover are controlled effectively with Gordon's Tri-Guard. A partial list of susceptible weeds is shown below:

### **HOW MUCH TO APPLY:**

For Kentucky Bluegrass, Fescue spp., Perennial Ryegrass, Bermudagrass, and Zoysiagrass: Apply 132.0 to 158.4 pounds (lbs.) of Gordon's Tri-Guard per acre of established turfgrass. Or the equivalent application rates are 3.0 to 3.6 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet (sq.ft.) of turfgrass.

The maximum application rate to turf is 1.0 pounds 2,4-D acid equivalent per acre per application per site. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.

Sequential or follow-up applications may be required for dense infestations of perennial and biennial weeds. Also, adverse environmental conditions prior or after application may reduce the effectiveness. If required, the treatment interval between the first and second applications should be approximately 30 days.

Drop spreaders, rotary spreaders, and other granular equipment should be calibrated for accurate and uniform applications of this product. Calibrate the equipment by applying the product over a measured or known area and adjust the equipment according to the recommendations of the equipment manufacturer. Refer to the rate table for the appropriate bag sizes and the area to be treated.

Optional: Equipment settings of drop spreaders, rotary spreaders, and other granular applicators may be presented on the container labels as requested by supplemental registrants.

### **APPLICATION SUGGESTIONS:**

- 1. Spring and fall applications are recommended for the best control. However, Gordon's Tri-Guard may be applied any time broadleaf weeds are present and actively growing.
- 2. Mow the turfgrass 2 to 3 days before application.
- 3. Water the turfgrass thoroughly (>½ inch) at least 1 to 2 days before application.
- 4. Schedule applications in the morning when dew is present. Or sprinkle or irrigate lightly (<¼ inch) before application to provide maximum control.
- 5. Rainfall or irrigation within 24 hours after application may reduce the effectiveness. Do not irrigate or water the turfgrass within 24 hours after application.
