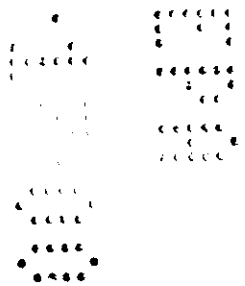
- Before applying remove dust and dirt, and/or any mucous secretions and saliva deposits from the face of the animal.

- Spread foam to approximately 1/8 inch thickness with clean cloth, curry comb or application mitt. Let stand on hair surface.
- *Do not rub in.*
- Apply up to 2 fluid ounces of product per adult animal and repeat daily as needed.
