



- This product kills plants by inhibiting the production of a substance found only in plants. It enters plants through the sprayed foliage and moves to the roots.
- This product is nonselective and will kill or injure all vegetation contacted by the spray. Do not spray plants or grasses you like — they may die too. Not recommended for spot weed control in lawns since this product kills lawn grasses.
- No soil residual activity any product not absorbed by plants breaks down into natural materials without moving in or on the soil to untreated plants.

- Plants that have not emerged at the time of application will not be controlled.
