1. Product Information [Where To Use]

EI-801 INSECTICIDE is intended for control of houseflies outdoors around houses, garbage cans, dumpsters and other garbage collection points, outdoor latrines, pet kennels, compost areas, and noncommercial animal housing including poultry houses, barns, and stables.

EI-801 INSECTICIDE can also be used indoors in non-residential and non-commercial areas, but only in areas where children, animals or pets cannot come in contact with or ingest the granules. See specific use instructions and precautions below. This product's active ingredient, spinosad, is biologically derived from the fermentation of Saccharopolyspora spinosa, a naturally occurring soil organism.

2. Use Precautions

- EI-801 INSECTICIDE contains a bittering agent. It also contains a fluorescent pigment that makes the bait more attractive to flies. Waterproof gloves are recommended when handling El-801 INSECTICIDE to avoid staining of skin or clothing.
- Keep in original container and store out of direct sunlight in a cool and dry location away from children, pets and livestock animals. To preserve effectiveness, reseal container immediately after measuring and using the product.
- Do not allow EI-801 INSECTICIDE to contact food, feedstuffs, and water. Protect exposed food, feedstuffs, and water, where necessary, to avoid contamination.
- Do not allow pets to feed on garbage treated with EI-801 INSECTICIDE.

Apply EI-801 INSECTICIDE only in locations inaccessible to children, livestock animals and pets
where bait granules cannot be picked up or where animals and pets cannot lick surfaces on which the
bait has been placed.

3. Application [How To Use]

One or a combination of the following bait application methods may be used:

Scatter Bait: Scatter EI-801 INSECTICIDE evenly in areas where flies are observed to be resting or feeding. Scatter uniformly at the rate of 1 oz per 125 sq.ft. of area. Do not put into piles. Do not use the scatter bait application method inside the house, or in areas where children, animals, or pets could come in contact with the granules. Re-apply when bait is no longer effective in controlling flies.

Bait Stations: Use in any commercially available bait station secured at least 4 feet above the ground and inaccessible to children, pets, and livestock animals. Add 1 oz of product to each of 4 bait stations and space the 4 stations as equally as possible within a 500 sq.ft. treatment area. Add product to replace amount consumed before the station is empty. Do not exceed 1 oz of product per station at any time. Reapply on a daily basis to maintain control when the fly population is large enough to consume 4 oz of product within a 500 square feet area in 1 day. However, when fly populations decrease, consumption of the bait also decreases, so reapply every 2 to 3 days to maintain adequate fly control. Replace bait station if physically damaged.

[4. Prepackaged Bait Stations [Station Bait] [Station Delivery Device]

[Note to Reviewer: An alternate package configuration is a prepackaged bait station. The bait station devices will be designed to deliver approximately 1 oz of bait per 125 sq.ft. of open house floor space or other use site through use of one or multiple station devices.]

Place a minimum of 1 [station delivery device] per XXX sq.ft. of open floor space of poultry house, barns, or stable in areas where flies are observed to be resting or feeding. Additional stations [delivery devices] may be used in large rooms or areas separated by hallways, doors, or screens.]

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
