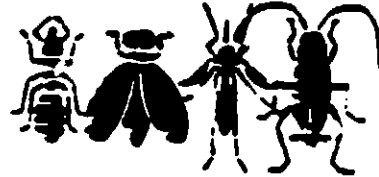

Spray thoroughly into hiding places (cracks, under mats, openings, under baseboards, storage areas and other areas). Spray directly on insects where possible.

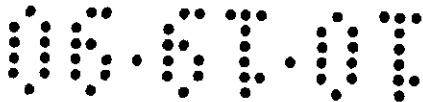
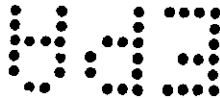
