 - a. Delete the phenol coefficient claims from the front panel.
 - b. Remove, from the Active Ingredients, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and adjust the INERT INGREDIENTS percentages accordingly.
 - c. Place the following misuse statement under the USE DIRECTIONS heading.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 - d. Change the statement "For School, Institutional and Industrial Uses" to read "For Schools, Non-Medical Institutional and Industrial Uses."


