The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling changes below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

a. The signal word: "Danger" must be placed directly under the heading: Keep out of reach of children.

b. Delete the statement: Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
REF: Registration Notice of June 27, 1990.

c. Delete the statement: Only for sale to, use and storage by service persons. REF: Registration Notice of June 27, 1990.

d. Delete the word: concentrated.

e. Revise the Total ingredients from 100.00% to read: 100.000% to be consistent with the rest of the ingredient section.

f. It has been noted that the second active ingredient declaration is incomplete. The words: "dimethyl benzyl" is missing from the second active ingredient. Refer to the last stamped label for the correct nomenclature.

2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

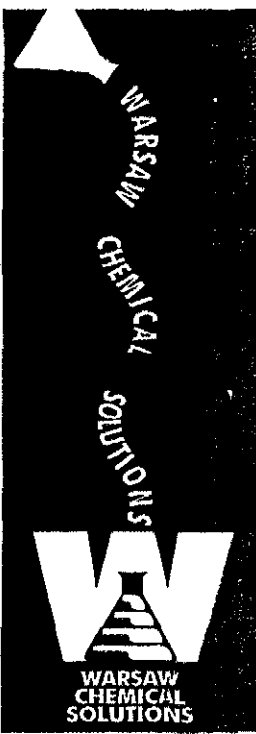

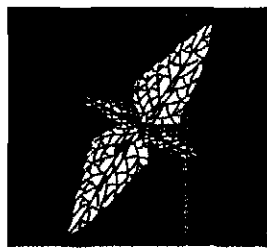

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use.
