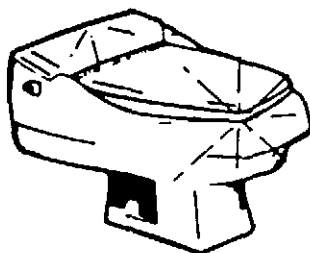

## DIRECT

It is a violation of law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions.

**To Clean Toilet:** Remove as much of the product as possible. Swab onto surface of the bowl. Allow to remain for 10 minutes. Remove scales and deposits. Flush rim at least 2 times. Pour 2 gallons of water into the bowl for as long as possible.

**To Disinfect Toilet:** Swab area and rim of the bowl. Remove as much of the product as possible. Thoroughly flush the bowl, including under the rim. Allow to remain for at least 10 minutes before use is completed.

Inadvertent spills should be cleaned up immediately. This product is not acid resistant. Thoroughly rinse the area after use.

Do not use on porcelain toilet bowls and fixtures.

**CHEMICAL HAZARD:** This product contains chlorine type bleach.
