FOR DISINFECTION: For use on non-porous hard surfaces such as floors, tables, walls, toilet seats, stoves, garbage cans, sinks, bathroom fixtures, urinals, shower/bath areas, metal surfaces, glazed porcelain and plastic surfaces. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits. Pre-clean all surfaces prior to disinfection. Thoroughly wet all surfaces. Use 2 1/2 ounces per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. Can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as soaking or spraying. The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use then discarded.

FOR SANITIZING: For use on non-porous hard surfaces such as floors, tables, walls, toilet seats, stoves, garbage cans, sinks, bathroom fixtures, urinals, shower/bath areas, metal surfaces, porcelain and plastic surfaces. For heavily soiled areas a pre-cleaning is recommended and required. Then use 1 ounce per gallon of water for a minimum contact time of 5 minutes in a single application. Can be applied with a mop, sponge, or cloth as well as spraying or soaking. The recommended use solution is prepared fresh for each use then discarded.

For clean, fresh laundry, diapers, sheets, linens, uniforms, aprons and grimy clothes. For extra cleaning power, deodorizing action add 2 1/2 oz. with regular detergent. Makes laundry odor free. For stubborn stains and spots, pre-dampen with full strength before adding to wash load to kill odor-causing bacteria, pre-soak in 2 oz. per gallon of water.
