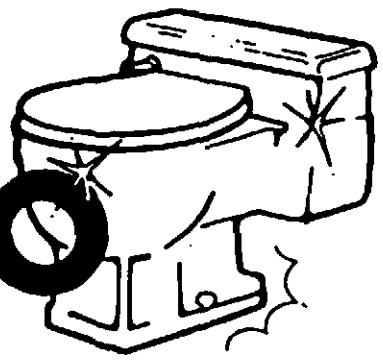

TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT TOILET BOWLS: To clean, stream around the bowl and up under the rim. Swab, then flush. Stubborn stains may require brushing.

To disinfect, swab to remove heavy soil and flush. Expel as much water as possible over the inner trap. Add 2 fl. oz. directly to water in toilet bowl or urinal. Brush to cover all interior surfaces of the bowl including under the rim. Allow disinfectant solution to remain at least 10 minutes. Flush. For badly stained bowls, repeat above treatment using 2 to 4 fl. oz.

NOTE: Do not use on sinks, bathtubs or any surface except toilets and urinals. Use of this material on other vitreous ware is done at users own risk.
