The following revised basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, will be acceptable provided the following corrections are made on the CSF.

Proposed Amendments:

- Updated Labeling per PR Notice 2002-1
- Revised basic formula (see CSF dated 11/04/03)

Data deficiency:

The basic CSF nominal must be corrected to 23.90% for hydrogen chloride as per the label.

General Comments:

The labeling, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with comments:

- Separate the environmental hazards statement from the storage and disposal statements and place the environmental hazards statement under the subheading "Environmental Hazards."

Other comments:

Submit for review a revised basic CSF incorporating the above revision

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product.

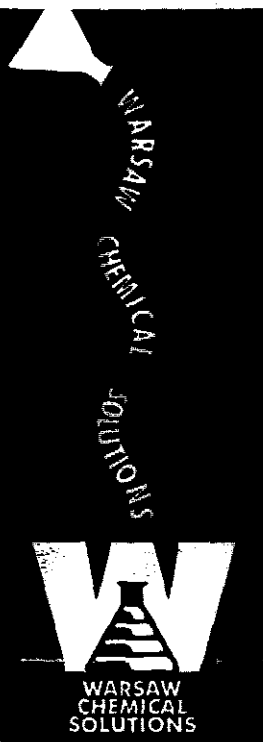

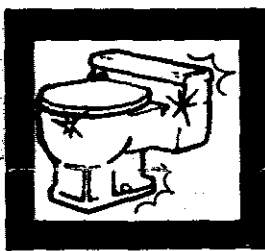

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
TO CLEAN AND DISINFECT TOILET BOWLS: To clean, stream around the bowl and up under the rim. Swab, then flush. Stubborn stains may require brushing.
To disinfect, swab to remove heavy soil and flush. Expel as much water as possible over the inner trap. Add 2 fl. oz. directly to water in toilet bowl or urinal. Brush to cover all interior surfaces of the bowl including under the rim. Allow disinfectant solution to remain at least 10 minutes. Flush. For badly stained bowls, repeat above treatment using 2 to 4 fl. oz. **NOTE:** Do not use on sinks, bathtubs or any surface except toilets and urinals. Use of this material on other vitreous ware is done at user's own risk.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.
IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water or 15-20 minutes. Call a Poison Control Center or doctor treatment advice.
