14 Apply throughout the year except when the ground is frozen. Best results are obtained  
15 after predominant species are well established in late Spring or early Summer. Before  
16 treating calibrate equipment to insure uniform cover of the area to be treated. Check the  
17 equipment manufacturer's recommendations for the necessary calibrations. Measure out the  
18 proper amount and apply.

## GENERAL WEED CONTROL

(Par.)

2 For general weed control on most weeds for an extended period of time on non-crop land

3 in areas such as parking lots, fence rows, loading ramp, railroad sidings, storage yards, and

4 industrial plant sites, apply 2 to 3 gallons Liquid Weed Killer or Semi-Soil Sterilant No. 5

5 per 1,000 sq. ft. of area to be treated (80 to 200 gallons per acre).

## 6 ANNUAL WEED AND GRASS CONTROL

(Par.)

7 For control of annual weeds and grasses such as Foxtail, Crabgrass, Barnyard Grass, Smart-

8 weed, Lambs Quarter, Pigweed, Ragweed, Ryegrass, Wild Oats, Cheatgrass, Broomsedge, apply

9 one to two gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. (80 to 80 gallons per acre).

## 10 PERENNIAL WEED AND GRASS CONTROL

11 For hard to kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Bur Ragweed, Indianrush Pea, Texas

12 Bluestem, Mouse-ear Poverty weed, Alkali Soda, Chickweed, Plantain, Dandelion, Bouncing Bet,

13 Johnson Grass, Saltgrass, Bracken Fern, and horsetail, apply 3 to 5 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft.

15 To control perennial weeds and grasses such as Smooth Brome, Canada Bluegrass, Purple Top

16 Quackgrass, and wild Carrot, apply 2 to 4 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. (80 to 160 gallons per

17 acre)

## 18 CAUTION
