Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital—immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition. After first aid is given (see First Aid Treatment Section) and if a doctor cannot come, take victim to clinic or hospital.

IMPORTANT! Before removing gloves, wash tham with soop and water. Always wash hands,

AFTER WORK, take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower, using seep and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving jeb. De not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with seep and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and lifter replaced according to instructions included with respirator.

#### POISON SIGNS (Symptoms)

Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes, Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die.

Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: Headache, nausea, womiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pin-point pupils, tightness in chest, labored breathing, nervousness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasms and coma.

#### FIRST AID TREATMENT

Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition.

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor sees victim. If swallowed and victim is awake (conscious) make him womit quickly, induce vomiting by sticking linger down throat or by giving soapy or strong sally water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person, Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 min-utes white removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately.

Antidete—administer atrophine sulfate in large doses, TWO to FOUR mg. intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atrophinization appear. 2-PAM Chleridg is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with autophine. DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILLIERS, Parathion is a strong cholinesterase inhibitor affecting that central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and resultancy depression. At first sign of pulmonary edems, the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued absorption, of the poison may occur and fatal relapses have been reported after inclusive improvement; VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.
