## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CROP—Tobacco

INSECTS—Hornworms, budworms, grasshoppers, flea beetles, aphids, sucklies, cabbage loopers, and stink bugs.

DISEASES—None

Make application at the rate of 20 to 35 pounds per acre (amount depending on the size of the plants) under calm conditions with a dusting machine that will give thorough coverage of all plant surfaces. Repeat applications as necessary.

CAUTION: Do not use within 5 days of priming or 15 days of cutting. Avoid plant juices coming in contact with skin or other parts of body of those engaged in cutting crop.

## WARNING

### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

May Be Fatal If Swallowed, Inhaled, or Absorbed Through Skin! Rapidly Absorbed Through Skin! Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water. Wear a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U. S. Department of Agriculture for parathion protection. Keep all unprotected persons out of operating areas or vicinity where there may be danger of drift. Vacated areas should not be re-entered until drifting insecticide and volatile residues have dissipated. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

To protect fish and wildlife, do not contaminate streams, lakes or ponds with this material.



### FIRST AID TREATMENT

ANTIDOTE: If swallowed. Give a teaspoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. Call a Physician Immediately.

If on skin. In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.

ATROPINE IS A DRUG

Parathion is a cholinesterase inhibitor and treatment of severe poisoning should include the use of Atropine. Thiodan produces central nervous system excitation which responds to the barbituric acid derivatives.
