Keep all unprotected persons and children away from treated area or where there is danger of drift

Do not rub eyes or mouth with hands. If you feel sick in any way, STOP work and get help right away. Call a doctor (physician) or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to parathion and describe his condition. After first aid is given, see the First Aid Treatment Section and if a doctor cannot come take victim to clinic or hospital.

IMPORTANT: Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating or drinking.

AFTER WORK. Take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower, using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes when leaving job. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Respirator should be cleaned and/or repaired according to instructions included with respirator.

Parathion is a very dangerous poison. It rapidly enters the body on contact with all skin surfaces and eyes. Clothing wet with this material must be removed immediately. Exposed persons must receive prompt medical treatment or they may die. Some of the signs and symptoms of poisoning are: headache, nausea, vomiting, cramps, weakness, blurred vision, pinpoint pupils, tightness in chest.

labored breathing, nervousness, sweating, watering of eyes, drooling or frothing of mouth and nose, muscle spasms and coma.

Can a factor (physical, etc.) cause or hasten immediate death? If the victim has been exposed to radiation, and describe his condition.

If breathing has stopped, start artificial respiration immediately and maintain until doctor arrives.

If swallowed and victim is awake, conscious, make him vomit quickly. Induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat or by giving salty or strong salty water to drink. Repeat until vomit is clear. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have victim lie down and keep quiet. See doctor immediately.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. See doctor immediately.

Anesthetic adjuvant atropine sulfate in large doses. Toxic effects may include tachycardia or bradycardia, as well as hypotension or hypertension. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. Prolonged exposure is usually fatal and may be enhanced in conjunction with atropine. DO NOT USE WITHIN 30 MINUTES OF TRANQUILIZERS. Paralysis is a life-threatening condition affecting the central and peripheral nervous systems and producing cardiac and respiratory depression. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be given supplemental oxygen and treated symptomatically. Continued accumulation of the drug may occur and further apnea has been reported after initial improvement. VERY CLOSE SUPERVISION OF THE PATIENT IS INDICATED FOR AT LEAST 48 HOURS.
