Spray EXCELCIDE Space Spra into entire room, after closing off all air current. Spray should be directed upward at wall and ceilings so that as many insects as possible can be contacted with a direct vapor or mist. EXCELCIDE Space Spra can be applied by means of an electric, portable logging device, such as the Dyna Fog, Challenger, Microsol, or BVI Foggers. Apply at the rate of one ounce per 1000 cu. ft. Room should be kept closed at least ten minutes after spraying. Repeat as often as necessary to keep listed insects under control. Periodic spraying of EXCELCIDE Space Spra assists in the control of new infestations of listed insects. Sweep up all dead and dying insects and destroy them at the close of the ten (10) minute period.

Infested stored food products, should be fumigated or treated by other effective methods using an accepted product intended for this purpose.

EXCELCIDE Space Spra is also designed for control of crawling insects: Ants and Silverfish, and stored product pests: Confused Flour Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Rice Beetles, Cadelles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, Dermestid Beetles, and Carpet Beetles, in their accessible stages. Thoroughly clean all flour, grain, and food dusts from horizontal surfaces, since these static accumulations encourage stored product pest breeding.

Spray EXCELCIDE Space Spra with permanent Spraying installations, portable electric sprayers, or foggers, as mentioned above, applying to walls, floors, baseboards, wall floor junctures, window sills, doorway areas, and storage areas.
