DIRECTIONS

Apply EXCELCIDE Flea and Tick Killer so that the animal gets an even coverage on coat, being sure that tips of the animal's hair are moist.

Apply lightly and rub into animal's coat. For long haired dogs, ruffle hair to reach skin. After 10 minutes dry the dog or cat with a towel. Comb and brush the coat.

Repeat once a week for a fresh, glossy coat.

Use on bedding and other areas as needed. Kills fleas in 5 to 10 minutes. Ticks are difficult to kill--they must be sprayed directly.
