DIRECTIONS: Apply throughout the year except when the gound is frozen. Best results are obtained after predominant species are well established in late Spring or early .Summer. Before treating calibrate equipment to insure uniform cover of the area to be treated. Check the equipment manufacturer's recommendations for the necessary calibrations. Measure out the proper amount and apply.

EQUIPMENT: Power sprayers, compressed air hand sprayers, knap sack sprayers, or an ordinary sprinkler can be used to apply this product. No dilution or agitation is required.
