For outdoor fogging for control of flying insects, i.e., Drosophila gnats (vinegar and fruit  
flies), Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Blowflies, and flying Moths.

DIRECTIONS

EXCELCLIDE Formula #22 is ready-to-use and needs no dilution.

For outdoor fogging the area to be treated should be completely covered with visible fog.  
This would be at the rate of approximately one gallon per acre. Plan fogging operation so  
that operator may continually move away from fog. Fogging should be done from windward side  
when apply fog. Fog the immediate outside perimeter of the building, and the outside sur-  
faces of building, screen doors, window frames, around outdoor light fixtures, and around  
dock areas.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes,  
on skin, or on clothing. Do not contaminate or store near feed or foodstuffs. Do not breathe  
spray mist. Wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Wash contaminated  
clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Do not use as a space spray. Do not use in  
the edible products areas of food processing plants. Do not fog this product in areas where  
food may be contaminated by the spray. Do not reuse containers. Destroy when empty. Do not

Application: Pour into sprayer. Spray infested surfaces only until wet.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS: Spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and trails and other localized areas infested with insects. Spray window sills and door frames where ants enter. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets, where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks, and infested areas of shelving in closets. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Repeat as necessary. Bedding should be replaced in animal quarters after treatment. Do not treat animals.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND FLYING MOTHS: Outdoors; For outdoor use only as an air in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or where ever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

CHIGGERS, ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS AND CLOVER MITES: Outdoors; For treatment of localized infestations of insects in outdoor areas, where there is no vegetation used for food or feed, spray infested areas. For ants, wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.
