

# **Copper Naphthenate Preservative**

DANGER! HARMFULL OR FATAL IF SWALLOWED. See Precautions on Back Panel.

CONTENTS: (1) (5) GALLONS

Gives long lasting protection to wood, canvas and rope. Checks decay. fungi, termites, and other insects.

Do not thin **COPPER NAPHTHENATE**. Apply liberally to obtain maximum protection. Old paint film and rotten wood should be removed. Clean away all loose particles and dust. Apply two flowing coats when brushing or spraying. When dipping, allow 30 minutes soaking time for wood not more than 1 inch thick. Soak heavy timbers overnight. Dip canvas or rope to wet through.

If treated wood surfaces are to be painted, allow at least 48 hours drying time before painting. When white and light tints are used, slight discoloration may occur. Discoloration will disappear after the second coat is applied if the wood is throughly seasoned and dry.
