- 2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Correct the first active ingredient to read: "Diazinon [0,0-Diethyl 0-(2-isopropyl-6-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate]."
 - b. Add the following paragraph under use directions of precautionary statements.

Do not use in the edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or served. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.

- c. Change percents in the footnote for piperonyl butoxide, technical to read 0.52% and 0.13%.
- 3. We have amended our records to reflect the change in product name from Wincide Super Residual Roach Killer to Wincide Residual Roach Killer.

This insecticide may be used with a hand, compression, mechanical or electric sprayer.

ROACHES, RESISTANT ROACHES, WATER-BUGS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS and SILVERFISH: Spray heavily into all cracks and crevices, along baseboards, around floor drains, behind and underneath cabinets, sinks, refrigerators, stoves, etc. Spray around window frames and door sills, pipes, harborages, breeding sites and wherever insects run, nest or hide. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.


ANTS: Thoroughly spray ant trails, ant hills and areas around door sills and window frames where pests might enter. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets and baseboards where ants come into the room from wall spaces and partitions. Repeat as necessary.

SILVERFISH: Spray baseboards, areas behind shelving, book cases and storage areas. Repeat as necessary.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Repeat as necessary.

FLIES. MOSQUITOES. WASPS and FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these pests. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate. In case of wasps, spray nest after dark when insects have returned to the nest. Repeat often since insecticidal residues on outside of buildings tend to deteriorate quite rapidly.

BROWN DOG TICKS: The roughty spray infested areas alound baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Applications should be repeated as infestitions warrant and as re-infectations occus. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this formulation.
