The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

1. Revise your "Storage and Disposal Statement" as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container.* Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

*If container is bottle, can, or jar, add this second sentence here: "Rinse thoroughly."

2. Add the following "Statement of Practical Treatment" at the end of your "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" section:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Give one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Launder clothing before reusing.

3. Delete the "s" in your product name for EPA Registration No. 2292-78. Because of the closeness of the names between this product and EPA Registration No. 2292-77, which results in unnecessary confusion, please submit a request to modify the name for one of these products.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
