## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### USE RESTRICTIONS

For use as a repellent for the control of pigeons, house sparrows, starlings and many other birds. For use in attics and wall voids only.

### APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Spread Shoo Bird Repellent on floor of attic apply in wall voids, using about 1 lb. for every 400 cu. ft. of treated space. Within a short time, exposed birds will leave treated spaces. After the birds leave, close up all openings through which birds could enter, such as small crevices around eaves, bases of rafters, around dormers. Make closures with strips of wood, metal, or oakum.
