

MINT DISINFECTANT AND DEODORANT For Use As A General Disinfectant and Deodorant

DIRECTIONS

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING PURPOSES IN INSTITUTIONS, SCHOOLS, HOTELS, BUILDINGS, THEATRES, RAILROAD TERMINALS, FACTORIES and HOMES. Use 21/2. ounces Disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply this solution so as to wet thoroughly all surfaces to be disinfected. Can be used in conjunction with scrub water or sprayed. Leaves the surface clean and fragrant. Excellent deodorant for use in toilet rooms, urinals, floors, sinks, water-closets, etc. For extremely dirty surfaces, such as garbage cans, exceptionally dirty urinals, etc., disinfect with a solution of B-ounces Disinfectant per gallon of water.

Athete's Foot Fungi: To aid in preventing the spread of athlete's foot fungi use 3-4 oz. per gallon of water for mopping floors of locker rooms, swimming pools, showers, etc.

FOR DISINFECTING HOUSEHOLD UTENSILS, REFRIGERATORS, DRAINBOARDS, SODA FOUNTAINS, etc.: First clean in regular manner, then wash thoroughly with a solution of 21/2-ounces Disinfectant per gallon of water, allowing contact for five minutes. Rin.e thoroughly again.
