USE DIRECTIONS

FOR CLEANING

Walls, floors, and other hard surfaces should be mopped or brushed with a solution containing 5.6 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned areas with fresh water.

Heavily soiled areas—mop or brush soiled surface with a solution containing 5.6 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water. Rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

GENERAL PURPOSE DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors and other hard surfaces in homes, schools, restaurants, rest rooms and other public areas—mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 3-1/2 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water.

Surfaces that are heavily soiled should be treated with 2 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water and then rinsed with fresh water. These surfaces which may later come in contact with food must be rinsed with a solution of 1% hydrochloric acid.

To disinfect locker rooms, showers, restrooms, and other areas where fungal infections are common—mop area with a solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water. This solution will destroy *Trichophyton interdigitale*, a causative agent of athlete's foot.

HOSPITAL DISINFECTION

To disinfect walls, floors, furniture and other hard surfaces in hospitals and other health care facilities—mop or brush surface to be treated with a solution containing 5-1/2 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water. These surfaces that are heavily soiled with blood, fecal matter, or exudate should be thoroughly scrubbed with a solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water and then rinsed with a fresh solution containing 2 ounces per gallon of water before disinfection.

SOLD BY:

SANITATION

To sanitize walls, floors and equipment—solution containing 3 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water. If surface is heavily soiled use DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER to insure thorough cleaning. Sanitize surfaces with DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER.

DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning—2 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water. DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER in household, industrial and institutional settings may be relied upon to deodorize areas and other areas where obnoxious odors are present. In restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes and other places where efficient cleaning is required, use DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER as directed.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Protect eyes and skin when handling.

FIRST AID:

In cases of contact, immediately flush with water for 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, drink promptly a large amount of water. If available, drink large quantities of water.

Probable mucosal damage—may cause irritation of stomach, respiratory distress.

Container Disposal: When empty, rinse container thoroughly with water and destroy it by crushing or burying in a safe place.

SOLD BY:

SANITATION

To sanitize walls, floors and equipment in food processing plants, first clean thoroughly with a solution containing 3 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water. If surfaces are heavily soiled use DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER at a rate of 5-6 ounces per gallon to insure thorough cleaning. Sanitize cleaned surfaces with a rinse solution containing 2 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water. Rinse with potable water after sanitation.

DEODORIZATION

To deodorize surfaces during cleaning, mop or brush surfaces with a solution containing 7 ounces of DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER per gallon of water.

DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER is an effective antibacterial cleaner designed for use in household, industrial and institutional cleaning. When used as directed, DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER will disinfect hard surfaces, such as floors, walls, counter tops and furniture. It may be relied upon to deodorize bathroom areas, garbage pails, food storage areas, kennel areas and other areas where obnoxious odors may develop. This product may be used as a general purpose antibacterial and pathogenic antifungal detergent in homes, schools, restaurants, hospitals, nursing homes, public rooms, food processing plants and in other places where efficient cleaning and antimicrobial action is desired. See left panel for use directions.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:

In cases of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsions may be needed.
