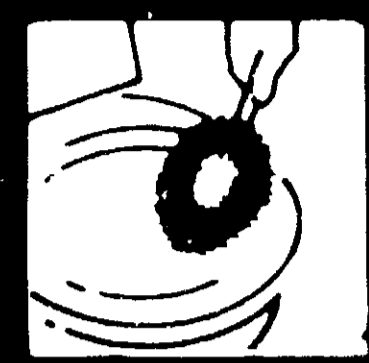
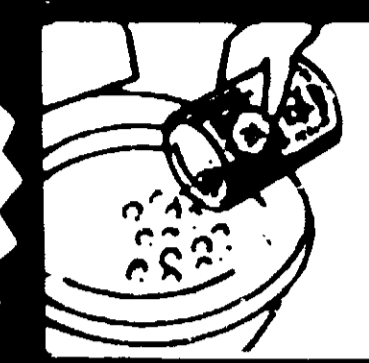

DIRECTIONS

TO DISINFECT AND CLEAN

Flush toilet. Sprinkle 1/2 cup of BOWL BRITE on bowl sides and into water. Let stand for a few minutes until bubbling stops. Then brush bowl, thoroughly, then flush.

TO REMOVE STAINS

Repeat above directions, but allow BOWL BRITE to remain on sides and in bowl for several hours or overnight before brushing and flushing. By allowing BOWL BRITE to remain in bowl for several hours, the trap and outlets not reached by mop or brush will be cleaned as well. Regular weekly use of BOWL BRITE will keep toilets clean, stain-free, and sanitary. Will not harm porcelain toilet bowls, septic tanks or plumbing. Do not use on sinks, bathtubs, or enameled or metal surfaces. Clean up spill with water immediately and rinse out brush or mop with water after use. Store in dry place and replace cap after using.
