FASCO 20-40 Cotton Dust is an insecticidal composition containing Toxaphene and Sulphur, specifically designed for use on cotton. It may be applied by ground equipment or by plane.

### DIRECTIONS

Use contrary to these directions may cause serious plant, crop or personal injury, excessive residues, unsatisfactory control or other unintended consequences.

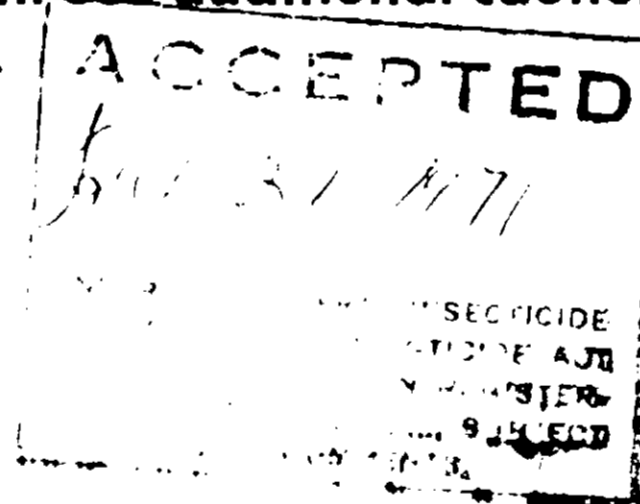
Against Boll Weevil, Cotton Bollworm, Leaf-worm, Fleahopper and to suppress Spider Mites use for 10 to 15 pounds of dust per acre. Start dusting at the rate of 10 to 12 pounds per acre and increase rate higher later in the season, depending upon plant growth and degree of infestation. Against Grasshoppers, apply 20 pounds per acre. Do not apply over 20 lbs. per acre on Cotton.

NOTE—The U. S. Food and Drug Administration has set tolerances for pesticide residues. Crops having residues in excess of their permitted tolerances should not be marketed and to do so may violate State law and will violate Federal law when sold in interstate commerce. Such crops should not be marketed without removal of such excess residues.
