Against Anthracnese, Downy Mildew, Gummy Stem Blight and certain other diseases, use 25 to not over 45 Pounds per acre, beginning when runners begin to form or when first signs of disease appear, repeating every 4 to 10 days as required to keep new growth covered. Do not use on summer squash within 7 days of harvest.

Blights, Grey Leafspot, and against Frageve Spot of Pepper, use 25 to 40 Pounds (not over 40 100103 pc, acre for Tomatoes) every 3 to 7 days, beginning with first indications of diseases.


--Against Alternaria Leafspot, Downy Mildew use at rate of 25 to 40 Pounds per acre (not over 45 Pounds for ollards and Turnips), 2 or 3 times each week beginning when plants come up in seed beds and every 5 days in the field. Do not apply with a 7 days of harvest.

CELERY — Against Early Blight use 25 to not over 45 Pounds per acre every 4 to 7 days. Dust plant beds every 4 to 7 days, beginning when plants come up. In field start when plants are established and dust every 5 days Remove residues at harvest by stripping, trimming and washing.


