FASCO Stored Grain Spray M-5 is a special purpose emulsifiable concentrate insecticide for use as a spray against insect pests of edible stored grain, unshelled peanuts, and seeds. This product contains "Premium Grade" Malathion.

DIRECTIONS

Use contrary to these directions may result in excess Malathion residues, in unsatisfactory control, or in other unintended consequences.

PEANUTS — For the protection of stored peanuts (unshelled) against infestations of Red Flour Beetle, Indian Meal Moth, Confused Flour Beetle, Rice Weevil, Flat Grain Beetle, Rusty Grain Beetle, Lessor Grain Borer, Granary Weevil and Saw-toothed Grain Beetle, apply FASCO GRAIN SPRAY M-5 as follows:

Residual Warehouse Spray — Before Storing Peanuts: Clean warehouse thoroughly of trash and old remains of peanuts 1-2 weeks before new peanut crop is stored. Thoroughly spray with sufficient pressure, interior of empty warehouse (including cracks and protected places), outside walls to a height of 6-8 feet, and the ground to a distance of about 6 feet from the warehouse. Mix 1 pint in sufficient water to make 2½ gallons of spray, or 1 gallon with 19 gallons of water. Apply finished spray at rate of 2 gallons per 1,000 square feet or to run-off.

Bulk Spray Treatment — Peanuts Going Into Storage: Apply 2½ pints FASCO STORED GRAIN SPRAY M-5 in 5 gallons of water per 15 tons of farmers' stock peanuts as they go into storage. Apply coarse spray uniformly, preferably use a suitable mechanical spray applicator which regulates rate of application to flow of peanuts. Otherwise, adjust pressure and size of nozzle opening to rate of flow of peanuts.

Do not use this product for Supplemental Surface Spray on Peanuts after Warehouse has been filled. FASCO PREMIUM MALATHION 25-WP should be used according to directions on the label.

Crib Residual Spray — For a residual wall and floor spray in Cribs, Storage Bins, Truck Beds, Grain Elevators, Box Cars, and Ships' Holds before loading grain, apply 1 gallon per 25 gallons of water making thorough application. Before applying spray, clean storage areas thoroughly. Remove and burn all sweepings and trash.

Bulk Spray Treatment — Grain Going Into Storage — Mix one pint per 2 to 5 gals. (amount depending upon nozzle used) of water per 1,000 bushels, and spray on the grain evenly as it is being loaded or turned into final storage.

NOTE — The U. S. Food and Drug Administration has set tolerances for pesticide residues. To market crops having excess residues may violate State law and will violate Federal law when sold in interstate commerce. If applications are needed later than allowed on this label, change to straight fungicide or to a mixture for which later use is directed.

CAUTION
