GENERAL INFORMATION

CARDI-X is a new granular non-selective weed killer composed of two proven and highly effective weed killing compounds. This combination provides a wider range of weeds controlled than either compound used alone when applied at normal dosage rates. The product is designed to be applied dry to the surface of the ground for control of weeds. The kill of weeds may be slow as the herbicide is absorbed through roots of weeds and must be carried to root zone by moisture. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of herbicide applied, soil type, rainfall, and other conditions.

DIRECTIONS

Apply **CARDI-X** just before or during the period of active growth of weeds. Before applying, measure area to be treated and select rate per acre desired to get amount needed for treatment. Calibrate over a small area and get even coverage with the rate/acre selected. A Seeder or Granular Herbicide Applicator may be used. 2 1/3 cups of **CARDI-X** per 100 square feet is approximately 400 pounds broadcast per acre rate. If dense growth is present, results will be improved if vegetation is removed before treatment. Do not apply to frozen ground.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL: To control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-crop land areas such as Utility, Highway, Pipeline and Railroad Right-of-Way, Petroleum Tank Farms, Lumber Yards, Storage Areas, Industrial Plant Sites, and Around Farm Buildings.

Apply 60 to 120 lbs. per acre to control **ANNUAL WEEDS** and **GRASSES** such as foxtail, crabgrass, ragweed, lambs'-quarters, watergrass, pigweed, purslane, Spanish needle, chickweed, wild mustard, and annual morning glory.

Apply 140 to 240 lbs. per acre to control **PERENNIAL WEEDS** and **GRASSES** such as Bahia-grass, dogfennel, goldenrod, plantain, and wild carrot.

Apply 300 to 600 lbs. per acre to control **HARD-TO-KILL PERENNIAL GRASSES** such as Johnsongrass, Bermudagrass, Dallisgrass, Nutgrass, and Vasey-grass.

Use the higher levels of the dosage rates on adsorptive soils (usually those high in organic matter or carbon).

DANGER TO FISH AND WILDLIFE

This product is poisonous to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of this product from areas treated. Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed of by punching holes in them and burying with wastes, or by burning. (Keep out of smoke).
